Mayor Schmaltz opened the meeting and welcomed everyone present to the hearing and than in turn introduced the three members present from the Calgary Regional Planning Commission. Mayor Schmaltz than explained briefly the reason for the General Plan and also the reasons for the Public Hearing. Mayor Schmaltz than asked if there were any written briefs prepared on the Plan, there was no response so he asked if there were any briefs to be heard orally.

The Fire Chief Mr. Leroy Whitnack asked if the proposed future development planned by the Village is planned to adequately accommodate the Fire Department and whether the new lines are going to be adequate as well.


Mr. Louis B. Hagel than asked if there was any plans in the future for better garbage disposal. Mayor Schmaltz commented that garbage disposal was now under the Department of Environment and some planning has already been done in this regards.

Mr. John Richter than asked if the water supply at present is going to be adequate for the Phaze 1 in the new sub-division and including all the private lots that were for sale. And also asked if our new lagoon would be able to handle all the new development. Mayor Schmaltz commented that the new lagoon was built for 600 people and could very easily and at a little expense be extended to handle 1500 people.


Mr. Richter than asked about the proposed new Commercial area planned along 1st Avenue and the C.P.R. right of way. Mayor Schmaltz gave a short explanation about this proposal and a map prepared by the Calgary Regional Planning Commission was passed through the residents for viewing.

As there were no more questions Mayor Schmaltz just explained a few of the proposed projects of the Village to all present. such as the replacement of the old water mains, the new sub-division etc.
