
Mayor Schmaltz opened the meeting and asked the Secretary to read out the questions and suggestions that were brought up at the Public Hearing.

1. The question re the Fire Department, The C.R.P.C.. assured that all the pipe sizes and also the water supply would be adequate for the expected growth.
2. The Garbage Disposal question; This is also being looked after with the intentions of future agreements with the Municipal District of Rockyview.
3. The water supply for future growth would also be adequate with another well ready to be tied into the existing system.
4. The new planned Commercial area along the C.P.R. right of way can possibly be developed through the Land Development Bank.


All agreed that no major changes to be made to the General Plan, and that the Director of the Planning Commission will give his final approval to the plan and this will enable the Village to give the final reading to the By-Law.

The Secretary showed Council the bid that the Recreation Board had received from Clay's Painting and Decorating for the painting of the interior of the Memorial Hall. Council agreed that the bid should be excepted by the Recreation Board.

There being no further business Mayor Schmaltz adjourned the meeting.
