THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING HELD THURSDAY JANUARY 26th, 1978, CALLED TO MEET WITH VILLAGE ENGINEERS TO OPEN TENDERS FOR WATER SUPPLY NO. 6, AND BEACON HEIGHTS SUB-DIVISION.

Mayor Richter called the meeting to order and in turn introduced the Engineers and also asked each contractor present to introduce themselves. Mayor Richter than asked Mr. Werenko of Reid Crowthers to begin opening the tenders. Mr. Werenko stated that there were 13 tenders for the water supply for Well No. 6 and he would open them first.


Mr. Werenko than explained that there were 11 tenders for the Beacon Heights Sub-division - Underground Utilities.
