

THE MINUTES OF THE COURT OF REVISION HELD IN BEISEKER
AT THE VILLAGE OFFICE ON MARCH 14, 1978.

PRESENT

It was moved by Councillor Benoit that Mayor Richter be the Chairman of the Court of Revision. The Chairman stated that two appeals were to be heard; one from Mrs. K.E. Mombourquitte, and one from Mr. C. Carter.

1. Mrs. K.E. Mombourquitte - Block Y, Plan 5184 GB
-.93 acres.

The letter from Mrs. Mombourquitte was read to the Court. In her letter, she stated that in April 1977 her house trailer had been removed, and that the property is not serviced by Village water and sewer. She therefore wondered why the taxes were so high and questioned the 13 mill assessment to the lagoon. After discussion of the situation, it was moved by Councillor Rice that the assessment be confirmed since it was pointed out that the assessment for 1978 had in fact been reduced from 3700 to 2040.
CARRIED.

2. Mr. Con Carter - NW 25 of lot 20 and all of lot 21
Block 13, Plan 1192.

There was indication that Mr. Carter felt the assessment on his property was too high. Mr. Gale explained that he had examined this property prior to the Court of Revision and suggested that the Court confirm the assessment. It was moved by Councillor Benoit that the Court confirm the assessment as per Mr. Gale's recommendation. CARRIED.
Councillor Carter abstained from the vote and discussion.

There being no further appeals, Mayor Richter adjourned the Court and thanked Mr. Gale for attending the hearings.
