Centennial Building and Village Office.


It was moved by Councillor Rice and seconded by

janitor. Mrs. Whitnack was instructed to inquire
about a replacement.


Since it does not seem that the Centennial Building

enough, the new janitor will be required to clean
these facilities "as necessary" rather than once
per week. For this extra work the rate of pay will
be \$150 per month for all three facilities.

Building, a vacuum cleaner will be purchased to
aid in the cleaning of this building.
