Minutes: The minutes of a regular meeting of the Council held on July 8th, 1957, were read.  
Councillor Lavoie moved that the minutes be adopted as read.

Statement: The Sec-Treas. presented the cash statement for the month ending July 31st. to the Council for their consideration.  
Councillor Velker moved that the statement be approved subject to the year end audit.

Corr. : The following correspondence was read and disposed of as follows:  
1. From the Dept. of Municipal Affairs enclosing forms containing title changes in the Village. Ordered filed.  
2. From the Royal Bank of Canada, Beiseker branch, informing the Council that collection charges on water and sewer bills would be increased to a straight 10¢ per collection.  
Council agreed to accept the increase.  
3. From McPherson & Thom Ltd. stating that they felt the charge for parts used in repairing Well No. I. was justified. After some discussion Council agreed to pay the account under protest.

CARRIED


The following plumbing and drainage permit application was put before the Council:

CARRIED


Mayor Schmaltz stated that Mr. Mike Schleppe was anxious to have Council's decision on supplying Mr. Schleppe with Village water service to his property on Block 4. This matter was discussed at some length, and it was agreed by the the Village would construct 66 Ft. of water line from the existing main and that Mr. Schleppe would have to pay for the remainder to his property. Mayor Schmaltz stated that this work would start as soon as possible.

Mayor Schmaltz reported that the health inspector had visited the Village in connection with the United Cafe property. The Mayor stated that Mr. Ings and himself had inspected the cafe in question and it appeared that the owner, Mr. Wong intended having considerable work done on the premises. In view of this it had been decided to call in the fire and wiring inspectors for additional reports on the condition of the building.

There being no further business to discuss at this time the meeting adjourned on a motion by Councillor Velker.
