The purpose of the meeting was to open bids for the position of Secretary-Treasurer.

The Mayor opened the one bid received which was by Mr. Don Smith at a salary of \$900.00 per annum.

After some discussion it was moved by Councillor Lavoie that the bid be accepted and that Mr. Smith be hired as Secretary-Treasurer at a salary of \$900.00 per annum. Carried

The Minister of Municipal Affairs was to be notified of this action.

Mr. Smith was then called into the meeting and notified of the action of the Council to which he agreed.


The discussion of the place for the Village office then arose and out of this it was agreed that it should be in the Smith building and of an area of about 12x32'. Secretary Smith agreed to pay for the cost of renovating and the rent was set at \$200.00 per year.

The Council also discussed the charge to be made to the Beiseker Curling Club for water during the curling season. It was set and agreed upon by the council at \$15.00 per season.
