CALL TO ORDER:

The hearing was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Deputy Mayor Benoit. Mayor Richter wished to act only as an observer during this hearing due to a precuniary interest.

BUSINESS:

The purpose of the hearing was to receive comments to Bylaw 79-14, being a proposed amendment to the Beiseker General Plan.

No written submissions were received.

Rick Miller of C.R.P.C. outlined the intent of the original submission.

Mr. Miskae, Development Officer of the M.D. of Rocky View questioned the authority of the Village to pass a bylaw which affects lands outside its jurisdiction.

Mr. Miskae also mentioned that since section 3.3.9 of the Draft Regional Plan states that

"Any planning measure or development proposal of a municipality which is deemed to be of mutual interest to adjoining municipalities shall be referred to the adjoining municipalities and the Commission for comment prior to a decision being made thereon."

he felt that comments on this bylaw should have been invited from the M.D. of Rocky View prior to this hearing.

Deputy Mayor Benoit moved that final passing of Bylaw 79-14 would be delayed for a reasonable length of time so that a written submission from the M.D. of Rocky View could be prepared. Carried.
