The Regional Planning Study

Mrs. Sokolan outlined the nature of the regional
planning system study and reviewed her preception
of its implications with Council. Council expressed
some concern over items included in the documents.
Each Councillor member and Administrator are to
review the document for further discussion and
possible preparation of a written submission
to Calgary Regional Planning Commission and the
Alberta Planning Board. The item will be considered
further at the regular meeting of January 25, 1982.

Beiseker Industrial Amendment

Council was informed about current developments
which regard to the Rockyview amendment for rural
Industrial Land Use. The draft amendment which Beiseker
had prepared was withdrawn from the Commission
meeting January 15, 1982, with a notice of Motion
being filed for a new further draft amendment
to be submitted to the next Planning Commission
meeting. The new draft of this proposed amendment
will be presented to Council February 8, 1982.

High Density Amendment - Area Structural Plan

The Public Hearing to consider the high density
amendment of the area Structural Plan area was
held Calgary Regional Planning Meeting January
15, 1982. No problems were encountered.


