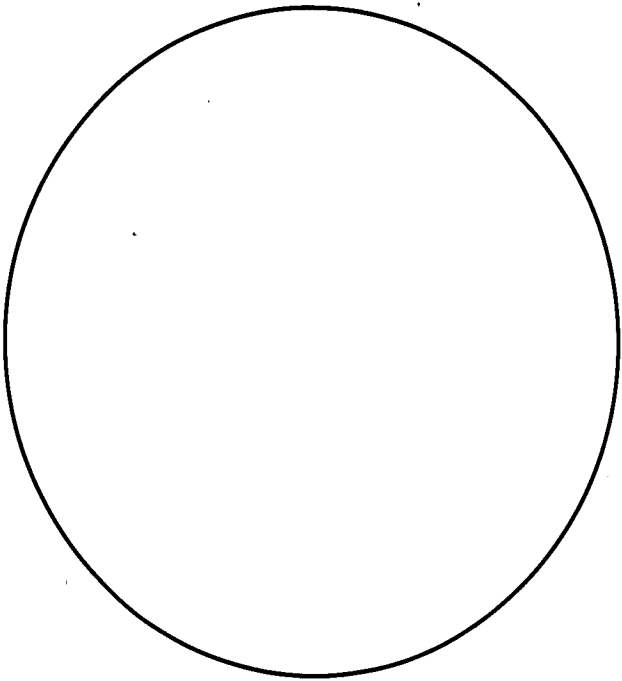

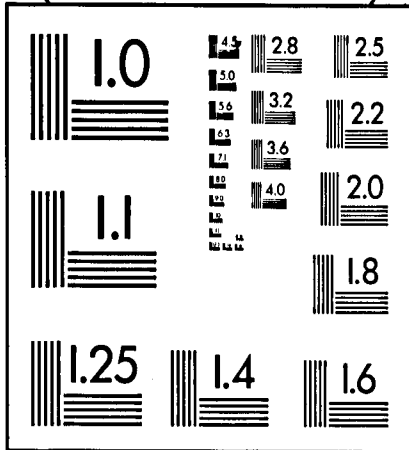

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Taylor called the meeting to order at 7:50 P.M.

ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Mayor Taylor moved adoption of the minutes of the regular meeting of Council held December 14, 1992 and the special meeting of Council held December 24, 1992 as presented Carried.

PUBLIC WORKS ITEMS

(a) Used Generator

Generator suppliers will be contacted to determine a value for our used generator. This item will be brought back to the next Council meeting.

(b) Shoring Devices

A mechanical shoring device can be purchased for \$149.50. This is considerably cheaper than the air shore device previously considered. Before a shoring device is purchased it will be determined if these can be rented and if so, at what rate.

(c) Foreman Performance Review

This item will be tabled until the next Council meeting.

(d) Horticulturalist Presentation

Everyone is invited to attend the horticulturalist presentation at the Beiseker Community School on February 3 from 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M.

(e) Water/Sewer Arena Addition Costs

The costs of the arena water/sewer installation was \$7,000.00. This does not include labour.

(f) Bobcat Broom

Although the bristles on the broom can be removed, they will be left on so that the sweeper is wide enough to do Main Street sidewalks.

PUBLIC WORKS ITEMS (Continued)

(g) Water Chlorine Levels

Both the total and free chlorine levels are now at acceptable levels.

(h) Arena Dirt Pile

The contractor still needs to be contacted regarding the pile. As the pile is frozen, any dirt that must be hauled away will be hauled in the Spring.

(i) Christmas Decorations

Because of an early wind storm and adverse weather, the decorations never looked as good as they could have looked. It is suggested that a large decoration be placed in front of the Village Office in December 1993.

(j) Water-Wastewater Seminar

This seminar will be held from March 9 to March 12 in Banff. Allen Bramley will register to write the Level 1 course.

(k) Snow Removal

Peter Gancer commended Public Works on the job they have been doing on street and sidewalk snow removal.

(l) Power Outage/Water Outage

During a recent power outage our back-up generator never kicked in. Public Works will have Brian Isert out to look at the system.

(m) Fire Hall Signs

"No Parking" signs will be placed in front of the Fire Hall.

(n) Community Centre Snow Removal

It is important that the sidewalks at the Community Centre are cleared of snow before all events.

(o) Truck Repairs

On December 24 the wind caught and pulled the hinge off of the door of the service truck. A price of over \$400.00 was quoted at Beiseker Auto Body. A quote should be obtained from the Auto Body in Linden to ensure that the Beiseker Auto Body quote is competitive.

(p) Hasp on Newspaper Storage Shed

When the weather lets up a new hasp must be put on the door of the storage shed at the transfer station.

(q) Christmas Trees

A Christmas Tree round up will be held on January 21.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

(a) Royal Bank

The Royal Bank will now accept Village utility payments at no charge. A minimum amount of cash will be left in the bank so that no service charges are charged to the Village of Beiseker. When debentures, which come immediately out of the Royal Bank account are due, deposits will be made.

(b) Presentations on the Municipal Government Act

The Administrator gave a summary of presentations on the proposed Municipal Government Act and the proposed Property Assessment Act that he attended in Calgary.

(c) Recycling

The Village continues to receive information on recycling and the Administrator will meet with Dave Whitfield of Alberta Environment on Thursday.

(a) Village of Rockyford

RE: Mutual Aid

The Village of Rockyford will be informed that the Village of Beiseker is in favour of a Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Rockyford. Administrator Martens and Councillor Gancer will attempt to meet with representatives of the Village of Rockyford.

GANCER

Fire Dept..- On Christmas Eve Santa Claus was on the Fire Pumper and they distributed 600 candy canes to Village of Beiseker residents.

- Canadian Western Natural Gas attended the last Fire Department meeting and gave a presentation on shutting off gas services.

- The Northeast Rocky View Fire Association now has a new radio station which allows the Northeast Rocky View Fire Department and the Beiseker Fire Department to communicate.

- The Fire Chief has been served with a subpoena to appear in court on Thursday, January 14 regarding the Beiseker Hotel Fire.

VAN HEE

- Solid Waste Management. Rate increases at the Association were set at the August 20 meeting and made effective October 19.

(a) Councillor Reports (Continued)

BELL

Drumheller Solid Waste Management Association - Councillor Bell attended the recent meeting with Councillor Van Hee and suggested that we may receive some of the increased fees back. The change in user fees was implemented because of additional services and the Drumheller Solid Waste Management Association now has a surplus. The Association considered lowering fees, however Councillor Bell suggested that instead of increasing and decreasing fees, the Association should provide dividends to their members when surpluses occur.

Rocky View Foundation - Councillor Bell attended their Christmas Party on December 16. The Crossfield Lions Club supplied food for all those in attendance and also provided a gift for each resident of the lodge.

Newspaper Recycling - On the December 19 newspaper recycling day tin cans were also collected. This was very successful and the next recycling day has been set for Saturday, January 16.

Hall Board - Councillor Bell attended the hall board meeting on December 29 as no Councillor has been appointed to that board. The Hall Board commented that they do not feel that they should have to pay liability insurance as it should be an operating expense of the Community Centre. The Hall Board feels that it should only pay for capital expenses.

The Administrator stated that the problem arises because the Hall Board formed the Beiseker Community Centre Society and that the insurance that the Hall Board is charged for is actually the Society's insurance. The Administrator will determine whether or not the Beiseker Community Centre Society requires this insurance.

Bovar - On December 21 Mayor Taylor had lunch with the Manager from Bovar Biomedical Services. Bob informed Mayor Taylor that they have received their temporary three month licence to operate. They are hoping to set up a tour of the facility on February 18 at 6:00 P.M.
