

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Fegan called the special meeting of the Village of Beiseker to order at 9:10 a.m. to discuss the Lagoon Project Cost overruns and the 3 ton dump truck engine.

#### **LAGOON PROJECT COST OVERRUNS**

Council discussed at length the cost overruns on the Lagoon project. The greatest area of concern is that the amount of dirt work that was done far exceeds the original budgeted amount in the contract. Also, there is a discrepancy on whether each load should be charged at 12.2 cubic meters or 16 cubic meters.

Councillor Walters moved to pay Rema-Caffe the next progress payment in the amount of \$98,946.80 but to leave the hold-back unpaid until the discrepancy with the dirt overrun have been resolved.

Councillor Courtman moved that no further payments be issued regarding the Lagoon project until satisfactory answers are given regarding the overrun costs.

Mayor Fegan advised he is in the process of setting up a meeting with our MLA Carol Haley to discuss funding.

Administration instructed to set up a meeting with Rema-Caffe, Bensons Industries (Engineering firm) and council to attempt to resolve the budget overruns on the Lagoon pojrect.
