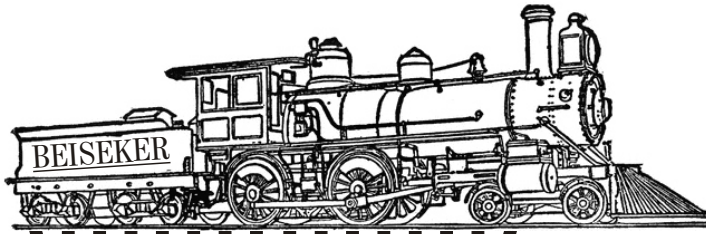

SATURDAY, MAY 12th - 10 am at Village Office.

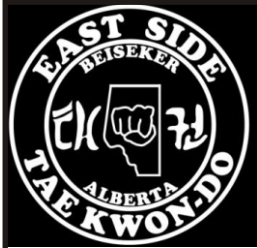

BLACK KNOT is a deadly tree fungus that is spreading! The fungus causes irregular swelling on a tree's branches. At first, the swelling is olive green, like new wood, but it then turns black and hard, and begins to strangle the affected branch. Prune out all knot-bearing branches during late fall or very early spring when trees are dormant and knots are easy to see. Because the fungus spreads through spores, do not compost the branches. Wrap them in plastic and throw away in the regular garbage. Disinfect pruning shears after each cut in order to reduce the likelihood of spreading the spores to a new branch.
