Fire Department reported:

A motion was passed to have Randy Smith, the fire chief of Rockyview County, provide his approval to have Beiseker reinstate the 24/7 volunteer department.

A motion was passed to increase the cost of 4th avenue and 9th street contract by \$160,000.

An estimate to repair the frost boils on Chinook Road was tabled.

A motion was passed to spend up to \$1000 to repair the carpet cleaner at the community hall.

A motion was passed to have CAO Leslie attend the SDAB training session on October 30, 2018.

A motion to write off an outstanding account was tabled to next meeting.

A motion was passed to request an extension for the period required for an IDP/ICF with Rockyview County in accordance with Ministerial Order # 027/18 to April 1, 2021 should this be necessary.

A motion was passed to spend \$4,000 to clear the flood water ditches of vegetation and debris this fall and have this as an annual budget item.

A motion was passed to rescind motion 2018-108 to approve the subdivision of Plan 4126HJ, Block A.

A motion was passed to approve the subdivision on Plan 4126HJ, Block A as recommended by local planning advisors, ISL Engineering and to approve the Letter of Decision to be forwarded to Devon Baerg of Creekside Productions Ltd.

A motion was passed to approve Policy #A-5, Bylaw Enforcement Policy.

A motion was made to refuse a request by citizen to waive tax penalties, and to table retribution for fence damage to next council meeting.
