A motion was made to approve a 16% 2019 Atco franchise fee.

A motion was approved to enter into a three-year agreement for hay at the Airport at \$30/acre.

A motion was made to approve the Village use the services of TaxService to manage tax accounts in arrears, and do not have a current tax recovery agreement plan. Also, any account that goes into arrears in the future will be assigned to TaxService.
