

# NOTIFICATION OF FILMING

Dear Neighbors:

The film production company, Farewell Productions Ltd. is currently working on a feature film, Rust City and will be filming in Beiseker, AB. The village of Beiseker has been selected as the key location for Rust City will be shot exclusively in Alberta.

We are filming the number of scenes for Rust City in your area. Please, take a moment to read this notice as it will provide you with information regarding our activities and how they may affect you.

Here is our current schedule of filming for Main Unit.

- Thursday, July 18      Unit trucks arrive and park by approximately 7 pm.
- Friday, July 19      Film the arrival of the hero characters by car at the Drive-in;  
down 1st Avenue to 6th Street. - daytime  
Film a character being dropped-off at the Drive-in - daytime  
Film the hero characters arriving at the Drive-in at Night.
- Sat-Sun July 20-21    No activity planned
- Monday, July 22      Film the interior of the Drive-in - daytime  
Film the exterior of the Drive-in at Night
- Tuesday, July 23     Film the interior of the Drive-in - daytime  
Film the exterior of the Drive-in - daytime and evening  
Film the hero characters arriving at the Drive-in at Night.
- Wednesday, July 24   Maintain the set but no film activity.

Note: Schedule for Second Unit's shoot is for Thursday, August 1 to Tuesday, August 6.

Please note we are working with the village of Beiseker and province of Alberta, we will have the number of work trucks parked on 5 St 200 blocks and 400 blocks by the community hall during the filming. (we will keep parking space at Golden Years Town & Country Club))
