BEISEKER CHAMBER OF COMMERCE BUSINESS PROFILE

McNair Sand & Gravel Ltd.

Just after the second world war Edward McNair was released from the Royal Canadian Air Force. It was at that time Edward bought an old used truck and began hauling gravel and grain in the summertime and ice and coal in the winter. He worked on many projects in southern Alberta and hauled out of many pits but the main pit he hauled out of was the Bosch pit west of Beiseker. In the very early 70s Edward bought 3/4 of a section of land from Benny Churchill 3 miles west of Beiseker. It was at that time he incorporated McNair Sand & Gravel Ltd. This pit has supplied the Beiseker area ever since. Gravel from this pit also has gone into many local projects expanding into the city of Calgary including Deerfoot Trail between 16th Ave. and Glenmore Trail.

McNair Sand & Gravel Ltd. was owned and operated by Edward McNair from the day it was Inc. until he sold it to his son Miles McNair in 2008. After Edward's passing in late 2013 the office was moved from his farmyard to Main Street Beiseker where it exists to this day. McNair Sand & Gravel Ltd is active in the community by supporting the Beiseker Ag Society, Beiseker Lions Club, Irricana Ag Society, Beiseker Fair days, and being an active member of the Beiseker Chamber of Commerce.

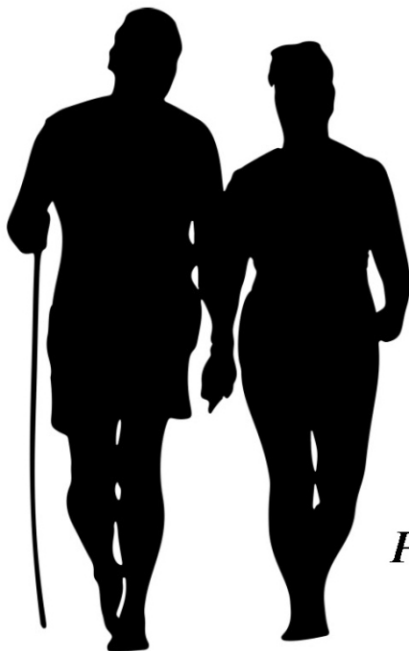

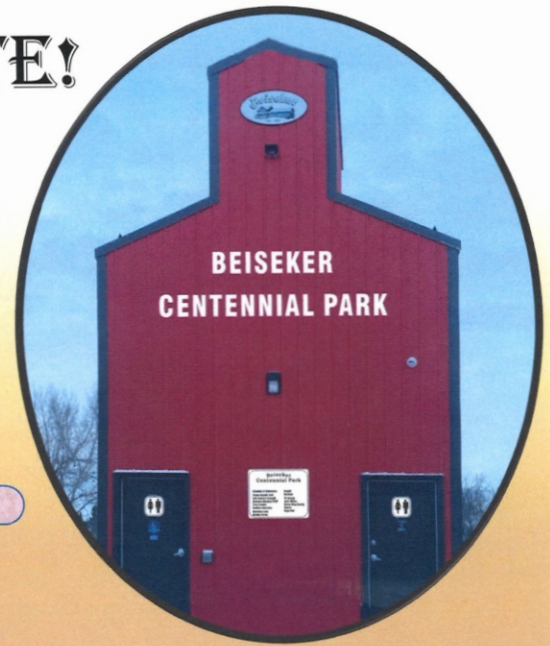

Development, Building, Electrical, Gas and Plumbing, are all subject to inspections. Obtaining permits and calling for inspections ensures the work conforms to the applicable Codes and Regulations. If a problem arises, such as an accident due to improper wiring, gas-fitting or structural integrity and the proper permits were not in place, insurance may not cover the cost of repairs or lawsuits.
